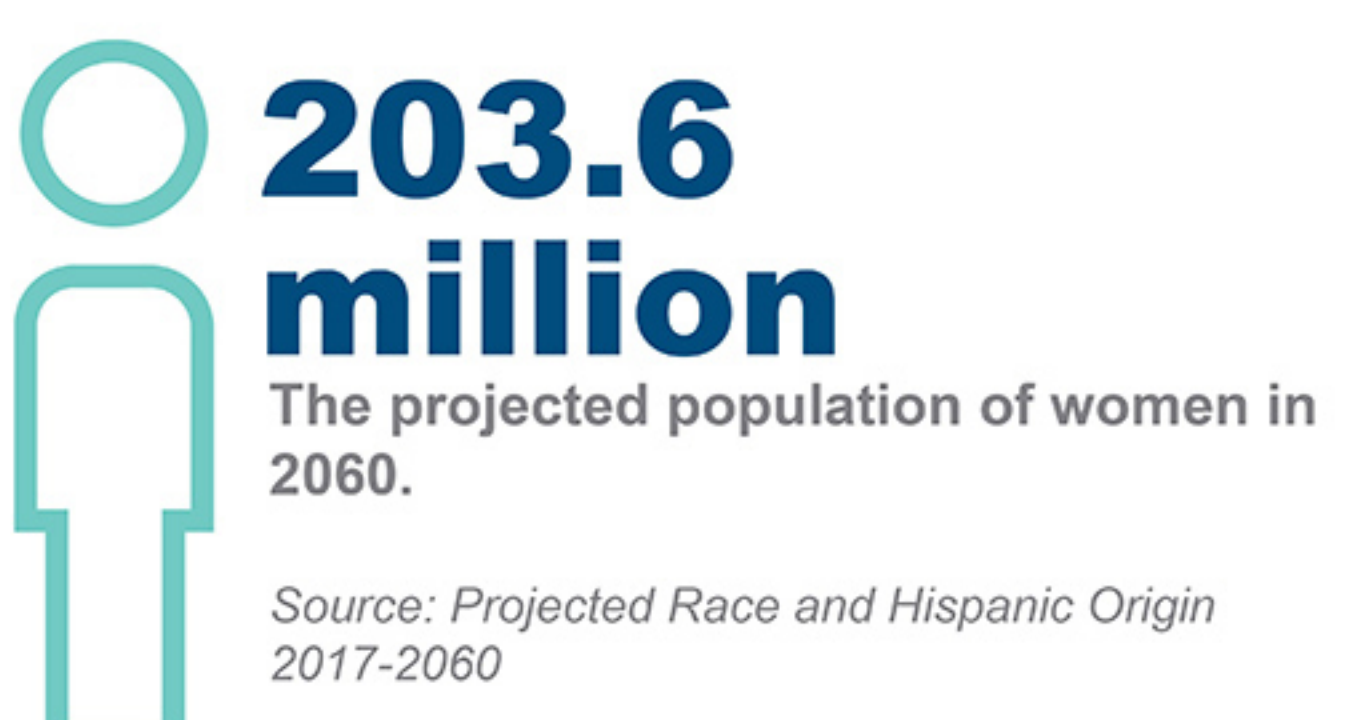
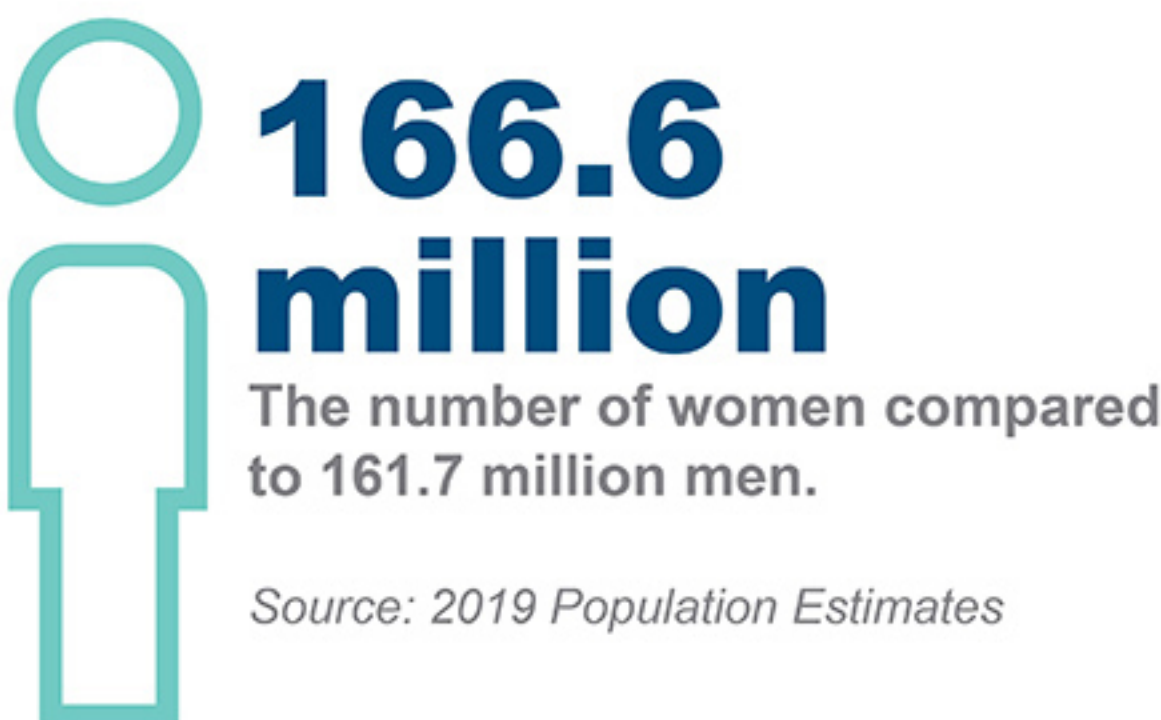

The median earnings of women who worked full-time year-round.

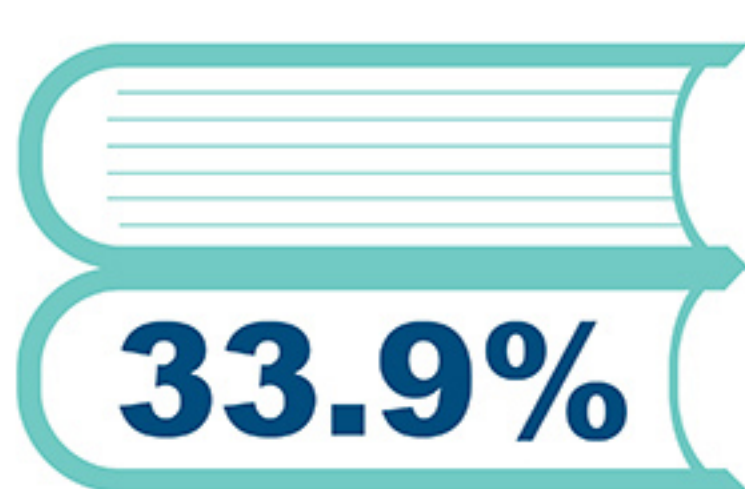

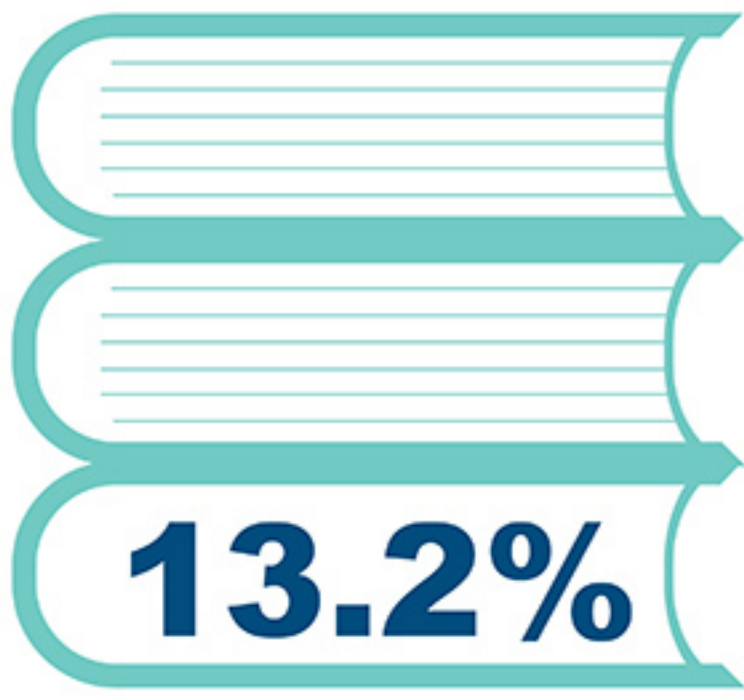
